

Hazardous Waste

All residents of the municipality may bring their household hazardous waste to the Transfer Station (located on Drummond Line (north of Base Line); or to the Household Hazardous Waste Department located at 400 Pido Road, Peterborough, Ontario.

Household hazardous waste (HHW) products are often recognized by the standardized warning symbols on the labels.

Examples of HHW:

- Batteries
- Small containers of used oil
- Paints
- Solvents
- Aerosols

Green Waste

Green waste for all the residents in our municipality is accepted at the Transfer Station on Drummond Line

Please place your Green Waste in paper yard waste bags – do not use plastic bags.

Examples of “green waste”

- Hedge clippings
- Grass clippings
- Indoor plants
- Leaves
- Plants and flowers
- Tree pruning – 2” (5cm) in diameter or less
- Weeds

Compost

Green Waste brought to the transfer station is sent to the County/City landfill on Bensfort Road where it is deposited at the central composting site where it is shredded and blended with autumn leaves to produce compost. The finished compost is screened and sold to residents and businesses throughout the City and County. The price of the compost depends on haul distance.
