## General Seasonal Labourer

The Township of Otonabee-South Monaghan is presently accepting applications for the position of “**General Seasonal Labourer.**” This position falls under the operational umbrella of two divisions – Public Works and Waste Management.

As a General Seasonal Labourer, you will be responsible for working alongside the public works personnel & the Waste Management Co-ordinator.

### Core responsibilities:

- General labour and maintenance duties which may include but not limited to: tree and brush cutting and chipping, sign maintenance, patching operations, road maintenance, sweeping, grass cutting, shovelling, raking, lifting, cleaning, garbage pick-up, general vehicle and equipment maintenance;
- Operating equipment safely and competently;
- Following prescribed health and safety procedures including wearing personal protective equipment;
- Assist with the receipt and transferal of household garbage, recycling materials, household hazardous waste, and items suitable for reuse
- Accurate daily record keeping ;
- Maintain transfer station site to required standards
- Other duties as assigned

### The successful candidate will possess:

- Grade 12 education or equivalent
- Minimum 3 months’ experience working in a related field
- Ability to handle physical effort and exertion
- Knowledge and understanding of proper safety procedures
- Must show initiative and ability to take direction and be able to work with minimum supervision
- Basic computer skills (MS Office)
- Valid Ontario driver’s licence

Good interpersonal skills are necessary, along with the ability to work on an “as needed” basis, in relation to weekends, etc. The range of pay for a fully qualified applicant is \$19.77 - \$23.53 per hour (2026 rate). A clean driver’s abstract and clean criminal records check must be provided by the successful candidate before a job offer is accepted.
