JOB SUMMARY:

To provide and support the safe, efficient, and high-quality operation of recreation and municipally owned facilities, parks, and outdoor sports fields. This position performs a variety of duties, including facility maintenance, arena and curling ice operations, parks operations, equipment operation, event setup, customer service, and general groundskeeping and custodial work.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

Recreation, Parks and Facilities – Operations and General Maintenance

1. Provide custodial services in all areas of the recreational complex and other municipal facilities as required. Set up and tear down spaces for rentals, programs, meetings, and special events.
2. Provide customer service to facility users, user groups, and members of the public.
3. Assist in maintaining and repairing machinery and equipment utilized at the complex and other facilities as required.
4. To provide and assist in the maintenance and inspection of ice surfaces in hockey and curling rinks to meet standards as outlined by the Recreation, Parks & Facilities Manager. Operate equipment necessary for ice maintenance and resurfacing of both the arena ice and curling ice surfaces.
5. Carry out labourer duties. Operate and maintain a variety of tools, vehicles, and equipment safely and effectively.
6. Carry out groundskeeping duties, including but not limited to: ride-on mowing, push mowing, trimming, litter collection, and sports field preparation
7. Follows all Municipal and Provincial requirements, policies and guidelines.
8. Assist seasonal co-workers in the operation of services and equipment.
9. Communicates operational updates, outstanding tasks, and facility conditions to incoming staff, and provides general guidance to seasonal staff as required to support daily operations

- Inside and outside work required. Working in extreme cold/hot and inclement weather. Occasional exposure to hazards.
- Working at heights
- Working alone, or as part of a team
- Operate machinery and work around potential safety hazards
- This position involves shift work, including evenings, weekends, and holidays

- Excellent customer service skills with the ability to deal with the public in a cordial and welcoming manner
- Able to handle issues in a non-confrontational manner
- Excellent communication skills and the ability to understand verbal and written instructions from the Manager, Lead Hand, or Director
- Requires good physical condition with the ability to climb, lift, and perform other physical exertion for extended periods of time
- Ability to efficiently operate a variety of equipment and power tools
